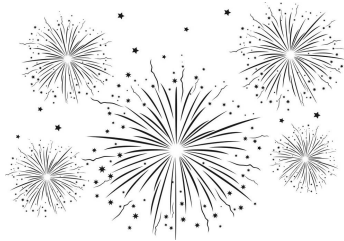

## Church Office and Building News

We continue to meet in person for worship as well as through Zoom and Facebook. Due to summer break, there are no Headstart kids in the building. Due to that, the **lady's** bathroom is **currently open for our use**. Because of this and our guidelines, the men's room is to be used by all others using the church. A lock is installed, so that when in use it can be locked on the inside. Our bathroom requirements include sanitizing after each use. If you use the bathroom there are disinfecting wipes provided in the bathroom stall and on the window sill. Please wipe the surfaces after use.

The church office hours at this time are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 1-3 pm with extended hours as able, the Pastor & the secretary will resume working at the office starting in July. The secretary is not working on Tuesday and Thursday (this is to ensure the serving of Food Pantry clients). Pastor Wendy continues to work on Wednesdays and Fridays. If no one answers the cell phone please leave a message and we will call you back (we can receive text messages as well). The secretary has this phone near her every day.

Please leave a message with your name and number if we do not answer. If you do not have access to a phone, please stop by the Food Pantry between 10:00 and 12:30 on Tuesday or Thursday. If you come without an appointment you will need to be scheduled for the next pantry day. Thank you!

## **Food Pantry News for May 2021**

Hello Church Family,

Thank you for your continued support and care for our community.

In May we were again able to offer our clients farm fresh eggs from a local source. In May we started to receive and provide fresh produce and herbs from our local farmers and the Cluster of Produce. The fresh produce we offered were Chives, oregano, mint, thyme, rhubarb, lettuce, cucumbers, carrots, celery, apples, tomatoes, potatoes, oranges, and farm-fresh eggs to our clients. This produce was provided through donations as well as purchased.

We had 37 households made up of 60 adults, 51 children under the age of 18, and 15 seniors over the age of 65, for a total of 126 individuals. We were able to give out 1,890 meals to these neighbors.

Our Church giving for May was 25 items and \$26.00. Your giving is very welcome by our clients. Through your giving, we can continue to serve our clients through the years. You make a difference in the lives of our neighbors.

### **Options for Tithing**

We have a few options set up to continue giving to the church. Your financial support is still important whether in person or virtually. We hope that some of these options will be helpful to you.

Our first options are to mail your offering to the church. Our mailing address is P.O. Box 104, Camden, NY 13316. We are checking our mail regularly, so your offering will be collected and counted regularly. The next option is similar, giving through your bank. You can set up an automatic payment through your bank, or you can choose when you want an offering to be sent. Your bank will print a check through this option and send it to the church (P.O. Box 104, Camden, NY 13316). This is available routinely with banks, not just at this time.

If you are joining worship in person we have started passing the collection plates again.

The next is through electronic giving. We now have a link on our Facebook page and our website to “give now”. This option allows you to use a credit/bank card directly from your bank account. You can choose from a drop-down menu for where you would like to give. You are also able to add another transaction at the same time. This allows, for example, you to give to the “general budget” and “Benevolence”.
